

Exhibitors' Regulations of Fantasy & Magic Con 2026

(as of 10.02.2026, applicable during the Fantasy & Magic Con 2026 event)

§ 1. General Provisions

1. These regulations ("Exhibitors' Regulations") define the rules of participation, obligations, and rights of exhibitors during the Fantasy & Magic Con 2026 event (hereinafter: the "Event").
2. These Regulations constitute an integral part of the Participation Regulations and apply to all exhibitors present at the Event.
3. An "Exhibitor" shall mean a natural person, legal entity, or organizational unit without legal personality that has been accepted by the Organizer to participate as an exhibitor and operates a booth of a commercial, promotional, informational, artistic, or service-related nature.
4. The Exhibitor participates in the Event based on an agreement or confirmation of the exhibitor application and after paying the required fee.
5. The Organizer reserves the right to amend these Regulations. In the event of changes significantly affecting the terms of participation, the Exhibitor has the right to withdraw and receive a refund in accordance with § 6 section 4.
6. The Organizer is Raccoon Business Kinga Zgorzelska, conducting business under the name Raccoon Business, entered in the Central Register and Information on Economic Activity (CEIDG), NIP: 8222418750, with its registered office at Aleje Jerozolimskie 123A, 02-017 Warsaw, 18th floor (hereinafter referred to as the "Organizer").

§ 2. Applications and Acceptance of Participation

1. Applications for participation are submitted by completing the application form available at <https://fantasymagiccon.pl/dla-wystawcow/> or sent electronically by the Organizer to the email address wystawcy@fantasymagiccon.pl
2. Applications will be accepted in two rounds:
Round I: from 10.02.2026 to 31.03.2026,
Round II: from 01.04.2026 to 30.04.2026.
Results of Round I will be announced by 14.04.2026, and results of Round II by 14.05.2026.
3. An Exhibitor may submit a maximum of one application.
4. Acceptance of the application occurs after its positive verification by the Organizer and email confirmation of booth allocation.
5. The Organizer reserves the right to refuse an application without providing a

reason, particularly in cases of:

- incompatibility of the business activity with the nature of the Event,
 - non-compliance of the booth with these Regulations,
 - exhaustion of available exhibition space.
6. The Exhibitor is obliged to pay the fee in accordance with the invoice within 2 weeks of receiving it by email to the address provided in the application.
 7. Acceptance of the application by the Organizer is equivalent to concluding an agreement for participation in the Event and confirming that the Exhibitor has read and accepted the Event and Exhibitors' Regulations.

§ 3. Booth Categories

1. The booth fee is determined according to the price list set out in § 4. Exhibitors may apply in three booth categories:
 - **Commercial Booths** - space subleased per square meter, where products may be sold and promotional booths may be set up.
 - **Artists' Alley** - A booth in the Artists' Alley may be rented only if the entire assortment is original (items with artistic value, such as original drawings sold on various media, e.g. keychains, stickers, posters, clothing, etc., handmade products such as plush toys, bags, clothing, and products based on original designs). If the assortment falls under both Commercial and Artistic categories, the booth must be registered as a commercial booth. In case of doubt regarding classification, assistance may be obtained by contacting: wystawcy@fantasymagiccon.pl.
 - **Food Booths** - space subleased per square meter for booths selling food prepared on-site.
2. In justified cases, the Organizer may grant discounts, reductions, or individual financial terms. This does not constitute grounds for claims by other exhibitors.
3. In the Artists' Alley, one booth may be shared by a maximum of 3 artists. Portfolios of all persons sharing the module must be submitted in the application form.

§ 4. Price List

COMMERCIAL BOOTH:

Price per 1 m² of commercial booth space:

- area up to 20 m² - PLN 230 net
- area above 20 m² - PLN 200 net

Minimum commercial booth area is 4 m² (2x2 m).

The price does not include equipment (furniture) and includes one exhibitor pass.

ARTISTS' ALLEY BOOTH:

Each Artists' Alley booth includes 1 module of 2 m × 2 m. The price includes two exhibitor passes and does not include furniture. Price: PLN 450 net.

The number of places in the Artists' Alley is limited.

The Exhibitor may use their own equipment or rent furniture for the duration of the Event according to the price list.

FOOD BOOTH:

Pricing for food booths is determined individually via email. Applications should be sent to wystawcy@fantasymagiccon.pl. The email must include the menu, social media (if available), and requirements regarding space, electricity, and equipment.

Electricity and equipment requirements must be specified precisely - changes during the event will be charged at 150% of the standard price.

ADDITIONAL SERVICES:

Corner booth - PLN 100 net

230V electricity connection - PLN 150 net

Table - PLN 50 (75 cm x 180 cm)

Chair - PLN 30

Additional exhibitor pass - PLN 100 net per piece

The limit for purchasing additional passes is determined individually.

For larger commercial and food booth areas, additional free passes are granted:

4 m² - 1 pass

8 m² - 2 passes

12 m² - 3 passes

16 m² - 4 passes

24+ m² - 5 passes

§ 5. Scope of Activity and Sales Rules

1. The Organizer of the Event is not responsible for the legal status of the business activity conducted by exhibitors.
2. The Organizer bears no legal responsibility for the legal status of graphics or media sold by exhibitors. The Organizer assumes that required permits are held, if applicable to the goods sold (e.g. food, cosmetics). The lack of such permits is entirely the responsibility of the party subleasing the booth at the Event.
3. Permitted activities in the Artists' Alley include:
 - sale of own literary works,
 - illustrations, prints, sketches, comics, artbooks, gadgets,
 - promotion of own artistic work,
 - portfolio presentations, artistic workshops, and meetings with creators,
 - creating drawings or sketches live,
 - in the case of artistic activities not described above, please contact the

Organizer by email for booth classification.

4. The following are prohibited at Artists' Alley booths:
 - sale of goods that do not constitute the creator's original work or own adaptation (e.g., 3D prints made based on third-party models),
 - sale of mass-produced products, ready-made figurines, clothing, jewelry, or non-original gadgets,
 - resale of goods purchased wholesale or from industrial production,
 - copies of other artists' drawings or modified graphics for which the exhibitor does not hold the appropriate license,
 - strict prohibition on the sale of graphics generated by artificial intelligence (AI),
 - sale of obscene, erotic, pornographic content or content containing elements of violence,
 - materials inciting hatred based on sexual orientation, gender, religion, race, or political views.
5. The following activities are permitted at commercial booths:
 - sale of licensed figurines, gadgets, and accessories,
 - sale of packaged food,
 - sale of both new and used games,
 - sale of literature, comics, and manga,
 - sale of sewn products such as clothing and plush toys,
 - sale of costumes, prop weapons, and cosplay accessories,
 - promotional booths,
 - demonstration booths,
 - sale of all goods permitted in the Artists' Alley is also allowed.

6. The following are prohibited at commercial booths:
 - sale of obscene, erotic, pornographic content or content containing elements of violence,
 - display and sale of so-called “mystery boxes” (i.e., all boxes/bags containing random products selected by the Exhibitor),
 - materials inciting hatred based on sexual orientation, gender, religion, race, or political views,
 - firearms and ammunition as defined by the Polish Act on Weapons and Ammunition,
 - bladed weapons - except for items with blunt edges,
 - explosive and pyrotechnic materials,
 - toxic, foul-smelling, or flammable substances,
 - strict prohibition on the sale of graphics generated by artificial intelligence (AI),
 - sale of bootlegs (counterfeit goods), goods from platforms such as AliExpress, Shein, Temu,
 - sale of alcohol, drugs, psychoactive substances, tobacco products, and e-cigarettes,
 - use of speakers, microphones, or lighting that may disturb other booths,
 - conducting sales or promotional activities outside the boundaries of the assigned booth.
7. The Organizer may request the removal of any product or material from display if deemed inconsistent with the Event’s rules.
8. The Organizer may order the removal of a booth or its staff if their activity violates the law, these Regulations, or public order.
9. The contractual penalty for non-compliance with sales prohibitions may amount to up to PLN 5,000 (in words: five thousand Polish zloty) net and will be determined individually by the Organizer. The contractual penalty does not exclude the right to seek compensation exceeding its amount if the actual damage exceeds the penalty.
10. The Exhibitor may conduct activities solely within the scope specified in the application and approved by the Organizer.
11. The Exhibitor may organize contests, presentations, or shows at their booth, provided prior agreement is obtained from the Organizer.

§ 8. Booth Arrangement and Equipment

1. The booth layout is determined by the Organizer.
2. The Exhibitor may not independently change the location, size, or layout of the booth without the Organizer’s written consent.
3. The Organizer does not guarantee assignment of a specific location, even in the case of previous editions or stated preferences.
4. Obiekt będzie dostępny dla Wystawców w celu montażu stoisk w piątek, 10.07, w godzinach 15:00-22:00 oraz w sobotę 11.07 od godziny 07:00.

5. Sales hours will be:
 - Saturday from 9:00 to 21:00,
 - Sunday from 9:00 to 18:00.
6. Booth dismantling will be possible on Sunday, 12 July, from 18:00 to 23:00.
7. In the event of changes to the schedule, the Organizer will inform Exhibitors via a technical notice.
8. If a booth is not dismantled within the designated time, the Organizer reserves the right to impose a contractual penalty of PLN 1,000 (in words: one thousand Polish zloty) net.
9. The Exhibitor is obliged to:
 - maintain cleanliness and order within their booth area,
 - comply with health and safety (H&S) and fire protection regulations,
 - not block aisles or emergency exits,
 - comply with the exhibition area opening hours.

§ 9. Shipment of Packages

1. It is permitted to send goods via courier service, provided the Organizer is informed in advance by email. Shipments must be delivered on Friday, 10 July; deliveries made on other dates will be returned to the sender. Each package must be clearly labeled with the name of the relevant booth.
2. The Organizer is not responsible for goods shipped via courier services.

§ 10. Cancellation, Changes, and Refunds

1. The Exhibitor may withdraw from participation in the Event by submitting a written statement via email.
2. In the event of withdrawal by the Exhibitor from the cooperation agreement covering booth participation, the booth fee paid by the Exhibitor shall be refunded:
 - 100% of the paid amount if cancellation occurs by 29 May 2026,
 - no refunds are provided after this date.
3. In the event of cancellation of the Event by the Organizer, the Exhibitor is entitled to a full refund within 31 days from the date of the Event.
4. In the event of a change in the time or location of the Event, the Exhibitor may withdraw within 14 days from the publication of the announcement on the Event website and email notification, with a full refund. Failure to submit a resignation shall be deemed acceptance of participation at the new location or time.
5. The Organizer does not reimburse any other costs incurred by the Exhibitor in connection with cancellation or change of the Event's location or date.

§ 11. Liability, Safety, and Image Rights

1. The Exhibitor is responsible for any damage caused by themselves, their employees, or collaborators.
2. The Exhibitor is obliged to follow the instructions of the Organizer, technical services, order services, and security staff.
3. The Organizer is not responsible for theft, loss, or damage to goods or booth equipment.
4. The Exhibitor declares that they have been informed that photographs and audiovisual recordings will be made during the Event. The Exhibitor consents to the free recording, reproduction, and dissemination of their image, captured in photographs and audiovisual materials taken during the Event, by the Organizer for promotional, marketing, and informational purposes, in electronic and printed form, without territorial or time limitations.

§ 12. Postanowienia końcowe

1. Submission of a booth application via the application form or email constitutes acceptance of these Exhibitors' Regulations.
2. In matters not regulated herein, the Participation Regulations of Fantasy & Magic Con 2026 and the provisions of Polish law shall apply.

4. In the event of amendments to the Regulations, the Exhibitor will be informed via email. Failure to notify non-acceptance of the new version within 7 days of the announcement shall be deemed acceptance of the amended Regulations.
5. Matters not covered by these Regulations shall be subject to discussion and decision by the Event Organizer.

§ 13. Processing of Personal Data and Image

1. The Organizer is the controller of participants' personal data.
2. Personal data are processed for the purposes of:
 - organization of the event and ticket sales handling,
 - registration services and contact with participants,
 - promotion of the event (in the case of photos and recordings).
3. Data is processed in accordance with applicable laws, including the GDPR.
4. Participants' image may be recorded as part of a public event and used for documentation and promotional purposes of the Organizer, in accordance with Article 81(2)(2) of the Polish Copyright Act and the provisions of the GDPR.
